Much of Hadrian's Wall runs over open countryside and is not recommended for wheelchairs and pushchairs.

 ■ Birdoswald Roman Fort: 01697 747602. Accessible parking, visitor centre, WC, shop, tearoom and part of site.

- Chesters Roman Fort: 01434 681379. Accessible parking, site and WC, but assistance is recommended.
- Corbridge Roman Town: 01434 632349. Accessible parking, WC, audio tour, museum and perimeter of site.
- Housesteads Roman Fort: 01434 344363. Limited access to site, and assistance is recommended. 50m walk on steep

gradient. Accessible parking at site (telephone in advance or ask at main car park at the bottom of the hill).
