CASE

You're the French King Louis XVI. It's early 1778, right after the American victory at Saratoga. Opp/choice: sign a formal treaty of alliance with the Americans, declare war on Britain, and intervene in the war? Or, maintain the status quo of low-level smuggling? (Intervention is now or never. "Intervene later" is not an option.)

INTERVENE

Observation: French help means a lot to the Americans. They desperately need a strong navy to tie down the British navy, or else they can't win. With us, victory is almost assured.

1. Geostrategic benefits

- a. Perfect opportunity to strike Britain, which must be done sooner or later. Spain and the Netherlands will pile on.
- b. Strengthen France (by acquiring colonies, expanding our empire)
- c. Weaken Britain, our cold war-style enemy
 - (i) in short term, by destroying materiel
- (ii) in medium term, by removing colonies
- (iii) in long term, by splitting up Britain from its colonies. 40% of population now supports France instead of Britain they'll be grateful to us

2. Economic benefits

- a. Permanently end British naval blockade that's strangling French shipping
 - b. Colonies
 - (i) give resources
 - (ii) provide a market for French goods, strengthening French industry.
- (iii) fits nicely with our policies of mercantilism
- c. Trade with America will be opened up, huge market, help French industry and hurt our competitor Britain's industry

DON'T INTERVENE

1. Unclear benefits

- a. Americans will probably lose
- (i) At Saratoga they got lucky, they've been getting their asses handed to them, 100% loss record in coastal areas
- (ii) Can't win: British control the seas
- b. French military can't help the Americans win
- (i) British navy is greater than ours, they'll continue to dominate NYC and elsewhere
- c. Even if the Americans somehow do win, they'll probably still favor the British over us due to cultural ties

2. Clear costs

- a. Money! This will cost a lot. Huge debt payments already.
- (i) Risk of default, which would be terrible, our credit would be ruined
- b. Will require us to raise taxes, hurting the economy
- c. Will crowd out other spending priorities
- (i) Infrastructure improvements, badly needed. Roads, canals, etc. Biggest reason why Britain is ahead of us in industrializing.
- (ii) Military spending our longterm strategic goal should be to take over continental Europe with our badass army, which is the best way to defeat Britain
- (iii) On your lavish palaces. You're a vain French king, you need your bling.
- 3. Your personal safety... safety to the French regime
- It's unstable, some "advisors" foresee a possible revolution in only a few years
- Will be made more unstable by having to raise food taxes, increasing both resentment and the risk of famine
- Will also be made more unstable by signing a formal treaty of alliance with a radical democratic group or revolutionaries, legitimizing them
- Your personal safety is at risk, and you're a weak-kneed coward. You're a cowardly French monarch, read your Plutarch.
