

The Arkeologi Museoa, is open to serve three key purposes in the management of archaeology in Biscay:

- To spread knowledge of local history, linking the past to the present as a way of helping society move towards the future.
- To encourage archaeological research by creating suitable services and infrastructures
- To ensure the safeguarding, conservation and restoration of archaeological remains.

The various areas of the museum have been set up with these purposes in mind.

Exhibition area

The exhibition area is spread over two floors. It seeks to explain the history of Bizkaia through the marks left by the area's inhabitants from prehistoric to more recent times. It is supplemented by learning centres in which experimentation and games are used to help visitors interpret the cultural heritage handed down to us by our ancestors.

Laboratories and research rooms


The laboratories and cataloguing rooms are for use by researchers, and are intended especially to cater for the needs of archaeological teams doing fieldwork in the area. They can be used by researchers to consult the Museum's collection or to clean, handle and classify the materials which have been recovered by themselves in archaeological digs before keeping them permanently in the Museum.

Storage area

This area is designed to store archaeological finds and the reports and statements that supply information about their origin and assess their support to the historical knowledge. It has as purpose to be a new archive of the historical memory of Bizkaia and ensure its conservation for future generations. It is provided by three large storerooms and a restoration workshop.

In the context of today's information and knowledge-based society, the Provincial Council of Bizkaia is seeking to turn this museum into a focal point for archaeological studies in the province, and to make the knowledge stored here available to society in general.




